So that if there is a decent (following moral standards that are acceptable to society) chance that an experiment will result in an important medical breakthrough that will reduce human suffering and death then it is justifiable to allow animal suffering. Animal experimentation is the (sometimes distasteful (unpleasant or morally offensive)) means

to much greater ends. Digress: topic sentence: Animal experiments are cruel because of the animals ' sufferingAnimals have the right to be treated as beings of value in themselves, not as the means to human ends.
